Second HFNZ Hui Organised

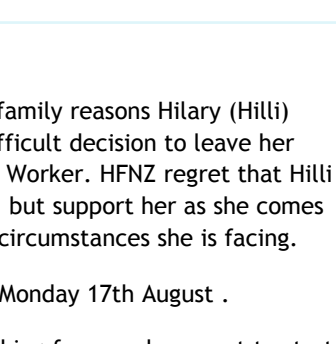

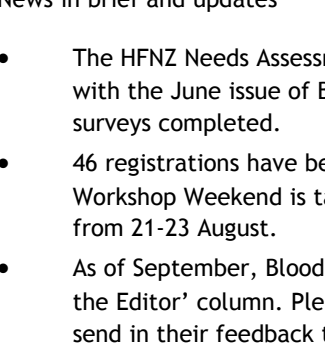
News in brief and updates
